PoliHub Recent Success Stories



- In 2015 Greenrail joined PoliHub and the following year won the SME Instrument Phase II of the European Commission equal to € 2.3mln
- In 2017 started the testing phase of the sleepers after which the product is ready for the introduction in the market.
- 2017: licensing contract of €75mln



- Nireos won S2P 2017 and StartCup Lombardia 2017, obtained grants from the European Commission and investments from business angels
- Founded in 2018 as startup and spinoff of Politecnico di Milano
- Already started the first deals with potential customers



- **Mathesia = Moxoff**, spinoff of the Politecnico di Milano + **Yottacle**, startup incubated in PoliHub.
- The platform is operating in the global market since 2015 and today it counts more than 50 companies subscriptions and thousands of experts from all over the world.
- In 2017 raised € 700.000 from a relevant entrepreneurs and Italian managers.



- The project originates from the research activity at PoliMi and MIT of its founders, and finds applications in infrastructure and industrial sectors, introducing higher performances at competitive prices.
- 2 patents filed, Startup prizes for 50+ k€ gained, working on field tests with major infrastructure and industrial Italian players



SPRINGA

- Springa won S2P2015 and StartCup Lombardia 2015, obtained seed investment of 175.000€.
- Founded in 2016 as startup and spinoff of Politecnico di Milano.
- 2 patents obtained after the development of several working prototypes.
- Successful crowdfunding campaign with more than 550 units sold and more than US\$ 1 million risen.
